### **JOB SUMMARY:**

The Analytics Specialist is responsible for providing analysis services for Growing Together and its partners as needed. The majority of the work involves collecting, analyzing, and reporting on the network's Education, Housing and Community Vibrancy efforts. The rest of the Analytics Specialist's time will be devoted to increase Growing Together's internal capacity and the capacity of the partners to collect quality data, analyze data in consistent ways, and report data as a collective. With the dual focus on analysis and technical assistance, the ideal candidate has a balance of technical skills and soft skills.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES/ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- Provide data and analysis support for Growing Together and partners
- Coordinate the collection, analysis, and reporting of outcome data across Growing Together strategic areas
- Lead portions of projects as needed and the ability to work effectively on multiple projects at once.
- Provide training and technical assistance to Growing Together partners to increase the quality of data collection, analysis, and reporting
- Provide data support for internal Growing Together operations
- Develop and implement key continuous improvement data metrics and to support processes for collective impact
- Maintain a data repository for quick access to demographic, housing and other neighborhood data related to Growing Together's target neighborhoods and the city of Tulsa
- Plan and complete regular analyses of Growing Together initiatives
- Conduct literature reviews and participate in writing of reports and presenting results to stakeholders.
- Work closely with the Communications Specialist to prepare regular report to the community partners, funders, and other stakeholders
- Perform other duties as assigned or requested

### **REQUIRED EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:**

- Bachelor's Degree in Economics, Education, Business, Industrial/Organizational Psychology, Political Science, Public Policy, or related field from an accredited college or university with a minimum of three years experience in analytical work OR a Master's degree.
- Must have experience working with vulnerable populations.
- Current or former resident of a Growing Together target neighborhood preferred.
